Duke Manufacturing Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, and located at St. Louis, Missouri, and doing business at 2222 North Ninth Street, St. Louis, Missouri, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for PASTRY COUNTERS, BAKERS' TABLES, SET-UP TABLES WITH TRAY RACKS, PLATE-STORAGE CABINETS, KITCHEN CABINETS, BACK BARS, PASTRY CASES, CAFETERIA COUNTERS, FOUNTAIN COUNTERS, GALVANIZED TOP TABLES, STEEL-TOP TABLES, WOOD-TOP TABLES, TABLES WITH DRAWERS, TABLES WITH SHELVING, TABLES WITH CLOSED CABINET BASE, METAL SHELVING, WALL CABINETS, STORAGE CABINETS, CENTER BARS, STOOLS, LUNCH COUNTERS, DELICATESSEN COUNTERS, AND SERVICE COUNTERS, in Class 32, Furniture

and upholstery, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended. The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business since September 9, 1925. The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the goods by metal tags.
