STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Aunt Nellie's Farm Kitchen, Inc., a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and located at Hartford, Wisconsin, and doing business at Hartford, Wisconsin, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for CANNED PEAS, CANNED CORN, CANNED BEANS, AND CANNED TOMATOES, in Class 46, Foods and ingredients of foods, and presents herewith five specimens or facsimiles showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.

The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business since July 1, 1928.

The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the goods, or to the packages containing the same by placing thereon a printed label on which the trade-mark is shown.
