### STATEMENT.

*To the Commissioner of Patents:*

Fisher Flouring Mills Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Washington, located and doing business at West Waterway, Harbor Island, Seattle, Washington, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for WHEAT FLOUR, in Class 46, Foods and ingredients of foods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by the applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.

The trade mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in the business of applicant since October 23, 1916.

The trade mark is applied to the goods by

printing or stenciling the same upon bags, barrels or other receptacles containing the goods or by applying labels to containers of the said goods, and in divers other ways.
