STATEMENT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Dictaphone Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York and having a principal place of business in the city of Bridgeport, county of Fairfield, State of Connecticut, and doing business at 375 Howard Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for **ELECTRICAL SOUND RECORDING MACHINES AND PARTS THEREOF**, in Class 21, Electrical apparatus, machines, and supplies.

The trade-mark consists of the word "Dictalog."

The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation since October 27, 1941.

The trade-mark is usually applied or affixed directly to the goods or to the packages containing the same by engraving, etching, printing, or embossing the trade-mark thereon or by applying thereto a label on which the trade-mark is shown.
